ISF Submission	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Add, Delete, Replace ISF - Allows user to create, update or delete an ISF shipment • Pending ISF Report – This is a valuable tool for tracking ISF shipments that were not accepted by U.S. Customs • ISF Progress Report – Allows Importer to pull ISF statistics received from CBP. The ISF Progress Report data is updated by the 10th of the month for the previous month.

ISF BOL Log	Allows user to review a complete history of U.S. Customs responses) for an ISF shipment. THIS IS VALUABLE REPORT AS IT WILL PROVIDE ACCEPTANCE, REJECTION AND WARNING MESSAGES.
Transmission Log	Allows user to create a ISF transmission report within a given date range

Action	<p>Options</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> New ISF Shipment – create a new ISF shipment, the bill of lading number must NOT exist in system. Replace Existing ISF Shipment – Modify or View an existing ISF shipment Deactivate Existing ISF Shipment – Cancel an existing ISF shipment. Deactivated ISF shipments will not be removed from the system.
Bill of Lading	<p>Enter master or house bill of lading number, no spaces or special characters. Remember to include SCAC code at the beginning of the bill of lading number, the SCAC code is usually four characters. If you are not sure if the bill of lading number includes the SCAC code, contact the carrier or NVOCC and ask them “does bill of lading number include SCAC?”</p>
Copy from Bill of Lading	<p>Enter existing bill of lading number to use as a template, the header details, additional reference(s), container(s), parties and HTS code details will automatically be copied to the new ISF shipment. The user can make any necessary changes to the new ISF shipment without affecting the old ISF shipment.</p>
